Respondents Details:

1. Fulfillment of My (students) Learning Needs:

From the total 1200 student respondents, maximum (74.00%) of the respondents rated as excellent in respect of fulfillment of their learning needs by curriculum, followed by 22.42% 2.92% and 0.67 % of respondents rated it as good, average, und below average respectively.

2. Application of the Curriculum to the Real Life Situation:

It is found that the maximum (72.42%) of student's respondent opined that the applicability of the curriculum to the real life situation found excellent, 19.75% think as good, 6.67% replied as it is average and 1.17% says as below average.

3. Clarity about the Course Objectives:

The highest (76.08%) respondents from the total students noted that clarity about the course objectives in curriculum found excellent; followed by 18.50% remarked as good. 4.92% think it is as average whereas 0.50% opined in this respect as below average.

4. Weightage Ghee to Employability:

From the total 1200 respondents, majority (77.08%) of student respondents opined that the Weightage given to employability in curriculum found excellent, 16.67% opined it is good, 5.08% rated it as average and remaining students (1.17%) are remarked as it is below average.

5. Weightage Given to Skill Development:

It is found that the highest (79.33%) number of respondents opined that the Weightage given to skill development in curriculum is found excellent. 15.42% mink in this case as good, 4.17% pined as average and only 1.08% remarked as it is below average.

6 Structure of the Syllabus:

The sis aspect of the feedback is consumed with structure of the syllabus. The collected information indicate that the maximum number of respondomi (77.92%) found the structure of the syllabus in curriculum is excellent, followed by 17.33% says it is good. 3.67% opined an is average whereas only 10% think it is below average.



7. Difficulty Level of the Course Contents:

From the total 1200 respondents, the maximum number of respondents 74.83% respondents rated as the difficulty level in the course contents in curriculum taught is found excellent followed by 18.42% 6.17%, 0.58% rated to difficulty level of course content in curriculum is as god, average and below average respectively.

8. Promotion of independent Thinking by Curriculum:

It is observed that majority (79.08%) of the students feel that promotion of independent thinking through curriculum taught is excellent, followed by 15.83% of them opined as good, 3.92% observed it is average and 1.17% remarked as below average in this respect.

From the total 1200 student's respondents, highest (7942%) of the respondents opined that the exposure to new knowledge and practices in curriculam tighe is fund excellent. 15.42% think is good, 4.08% observed as average and 108% says below average in this respect.

It is observed that the maximum (76.67%) respondents think that Weightage to practical and field work in curriculum is found excellent. Respondents Details:

1. Applicability of the syllabus to Local Developmental Needs:

The 95 teacher respondents had given their responses on applicability of the syllabus to local developmental needs. It is found that majority (60%) respondents rated as excellent. followed by 32.63 and 7.37respondents says average, and below average respectively.

2. Difficulty Level of the Syllabus:

It is found that the maximum 47.37% of teacher respondent opined that the difficulty level of the syllabus in curriculum is found excellent, followed by 44.21% think it is good, 8.42% replied as it is average.

3. Clarity about the Course Objectives:

The highest (67.37%) respondents from the total teacher think that clarity about the course objectives in curriculum found excellent; followed by 30.53% remarked as good, 2.11% opined it is as average, no one select the below average option in this respect.

4. Weightage given to Employability:

The fourth aspect of this survey concerned with Weightage given to employability in curriculum. From the total 95 teacher respondents, majority teachers (52.63%) says that the Weightage given to employability in curriculum found excellent, 35.79% observed it is good, 11.58% rated it as average.

5. Depth of the Course Content:

As far as depth of the course contents is concerned maximum (58.95%) number of respondents opined that they found it excellent, followed by 33.68% think it is as good, 7.37 remarked it as average and responses not received as below average in this case.

6. Incorporation of the Latest Knowledge & Information:

The six aspect of the feedback is concerned with incorporation of the latest knowledge & information. It is observed that the maximum (56.84%) teachers says that the incorporation of the latest knowledge & information in curriculum found excellent, 35.79% says it is good, 6.32% rated as it is average whereas 1.05% think it is as below average.



7. Research Possibilities:

From the total 95 teacher respondents, the maximum (60%) respondents found research possibilities in curriculum found excellent, followed by 29.47% and 10.53 replied as good and average respectively in this respect. Responses not received as below average in this respect.

8. Mechanism Used for Development/Revision of Curriculum by BoS:

The Maximum (58.95%) of the teachers says mechanism used for development / revision of curriculum is found excellent, followed by 35.79% opined as it is good, 5.26% says average and no response received as below average in this case.

10. Relevance of Course Outcomes:


It is noted that the maximum respondents (63.16%) opined as it is found excellent, followed by 35.79 and 1.05 replied as good and average in this respect.

Respondents Details:

1. Weightage Given to Employability/Skill Development:

In the academic year 2020-2021, total 22 employer respondents marked their responses on Weightage given to employability / skill development in curriculum. It is observed that majority (63.63%) of the respondents says excellent in this regard and 36.37% respondents replied as good. No responses found in favor of average and below average option on the given question.

2. Fulfillment of Demands of at Our Workplace:

It is found that the highest 63.63% of employer remarked that the fulfillment of demands of at our workplace in curriculum found excellent, followed by 27.27 opined as good and 9.1% replied as average in this respect. Nobody selected the option below average from the respondents.

3. Inclusion of Course Contents Suitable to My Industry:

The maximum (54.55%) respondent employer opined that inclusion of course contents suitable to their industry found good followed by 45.45 observed it is excellent. Responses not received to average and below average option in this case.

4. Relevance to Current Knowledge and Information:

From the total 22 employer respondent's majority (63.63%) number of respondents opined that the relevance to current knowledge and information in curriculum found excellent. followed by 27.27% think as it is good and 9.1 says as average. Responses not received as below average in this respect.
