Respondents Details:

1. Fulfillment of My (students) Learning Needs:

From the total 2742 student respondents, highest (78.15%) of the respondents rated as excellent to the fulfillment of their learning needs by curriculum, followed by 17.21%, 3.61%, and 1.2% of respondents have rated it as good, average, and below average respectively.

2. Application of the Curriculum to the Real Life Situation:

It is found that the more 78.01% of student's respondent opined that the applicability of the curriculum to the real life situation is excellent, 15.35% think it is as good, 5.69% replied as it is average and 0.95% says as below average.

3. Clarity about the Course Objectives:

The highest (79.80%) respondents from the total students noted that clarity about the course objectives in curriculum found excellent; followed by 15.43% remarked as good, 3.79% think it is as average whereas 0.98% opined in this respect as below average.

4. Weightage Given to Employability:

From the total 2742 respondents, maximum (79.61%) of student respondents says that the Weightage given to employability in curriculum is excellent, 14.04% opined it is good, 5.25% rated it is as average and remaining students (1.09%) are remarked as it is below average.

5. Weightage Given to Skill Development:

It is found that the highest (81.33%) number of respondents think that the Weightage given to skill development in curriculum is excellent, Followed by 13.17% think in this case as good, 4.30% opined as average and only 1.20% remarked as it is as below average.

6. Structure of the Syllabus:

The six aspect of the feedback is concerned with structure of the syllabus. The collected information indicate that the maximum number of respondents (78.81%) found the structure of the syllabus in curriculum is excellent, followed by 14.59% says it is good, 4.70% opined as it is average whereas only 1.90 think it is below average.



7. Difficulty Level of the Course Contents:

From the total 2742 respondents, the maximum number of respondents 79.72% respondents rated as the difficulty level in the course contents in curriculum taught is found excellent. 14.55%. 56%, 1.17% rated to difficulty level of course content in curriculum is as good average and below average respectively.

8. Promotion of independent Thinking by Curriculum:

It is observed that Maximum (82.09%) of the students feel that promotion of independent thinking through curriculum taught is excellent, followed by 12.44% of them opined as good. 4.27% observed it is average and 1.20 remarked below average in this respect.

9. Exposure to New Knowledge and Practices:

From the total 2742 student's respondents, highest 81.15% of the respondents opined that the exposure to new knowledge and practices in curriculum taught is found excellent. 12.18% think as good, 4.85% observed as average and 1.82% says below average in this respect.

10. Weightage to Practical or field work:

According to collected responses it is observed that the highest (80.71%) respondents think that Weightage to practical and field work in curriculum is found excellent. The 12.55% respondents remarked in this respect as good, 5.00% says Weightage given to practical or field work in curriculum is average and 1.75 says it is below average.

11. Creation of Interest to Pursue Higher Education:

From the total 2742 respondents highest (82.93%) opined that the creation of interest to pursue higher education from curriculum is excellent, followed by 10.90% respondents think that it is good, 4.70% says average, and 1.46% replied it is below average.

12. Overall rating:

It is found that maximum 80.93% students respondent rated to curriculum found excellent. 13.64% think it is good, 4.49% rated it as average and very few (0.95%) given overall rating to the curriculum is below average.

2. Difficulty Level of the Syllabus:

It is found that the more 45.56% of teacher respondent opined that the difficulty level of the syllabus in curriculum is found good. Followed by 31.11% think it is as excellent, 22.22% replied as it is average and 1.11% says it as below average. The highest (46.67%) respondents from the total teacher think that clarity about the course

5. Depth of the Course Content:

As far as depth of the course contents is concerned highest (47.78%) number of respondents opined that the they found it good, Followed by 41.11% think it is as excellent, 10 %% remarked it as average and only 1.11% says as the depth of the course content in curriculum is as below average.

6. Incorporation of the Latest Knowledge & Information:

The six aspect of the feedback is concerned with incorporation of the latest knowledge & information. It is observed that the maximum (48.89%) teachers says that the Incorporation of the latest knowledge & information in curriculum is good, 31.11% says it is excellent, 16.67% rated as it is average whereas 3.33 think it is below average.



7. Research Possibilities:

From the total 90 teacher respondents, the equal number of respondents (ie. 41.11%) respondents rated as the research possibilities in curriculum taught is found excellent and good. 13.33% and 4.44% rated to research possibilities in curriculum as average and below average respectively.

8. Mechanism Used for Development/Revision of Curriculum by BOS:

The Maximum (47.78%) of the teachers says mechanism used for development / revision of curriculum is found good, 35.56 opined as it is excellent. 15.56% and 1.11% of them opined average and below average respectively.



From the total 396 respondents, 70.45% of the respondents rated fulfillment of learning: needs from curriculum as found excellent. 26.26%, 2.53%, and 0.76% of respondents have rated as good, average, and below average respectively.

2. Application of the Curriculum to the Real Life:

It is observed that the majority 67.68% of alumni respondents opined that the applicability of the curriculum to the real life is excellent, followed by 25% think it is as good. 6.31 remarked as average and 1.01% says it is below average.

3. Clarity about the course Objectives:

The highest 75.76% respondents from the total alumni remarked that the clarity in course objectives found excellent, 19.19% opined in this respect as it is good, 4.29 rated it is as average whereas 0.76 think it is below average.

4. Weightage given to Employability:

From the total 396 alumni respondents, it is found that the maximum (64.65%) alumni opined that the Weightage given to the employability in curriculum is excellent, followed by 29.29%, 4.80% and 1.26% alumni remarked as good, average and below average respectively.
